Day 1) 25 Jan 17 Wed Arrival Hong Kong

Upon arrival, pls contact the airport counter B01 at Hall B for your SIC transfer to your hotel. A map will be given to you before your arrival for the meeting point to join a relaxing and comfortable cruise to Lamma Island to have a Seafood dinner on the Island (no transfer provide hotel/Pier/hotel) You will have an early night after your long haul flight.

Buffet breakfast at your hotel, explore the mixture of east and west in Western part of the Hong Kong Island by



taking first with the newest routing of the metro to the western district with our Russian speaking guide, walking back from there to the Central area, through the most interesting parts, the mixture of old colonial buildings and high-tech towers, hawker stalls and French restaurants, typical Chinese homes

and the housing of the foreigners – fascinating! We walk to Central Market and then take the Hillside Escalator Link which is an 800 meters long moving

Arriving the junction with Ladder Street we come to the historical Man Mo Temple, one of the oldest temples in Hong Kong. On Cat Street you can find more of Chinese antique shops selling small interesting items, time to show your bargaining skills, a typical Dim Sum lunch will be arranged enroute

of souvenir, and will be opened till next morning, same as the Metro, people will stay 02 to 03 hrs there .. that's why the best way to visit there by yourself and anytime you want)

Day 3) 27 Jan 17 Fri (B/-/D)

Buffet Breakfast at your hotel and then followed by a SIC tour to visit the Lantau Island, first will board the Public Ferry for a scenic cruise to Silvermine Bay on Lantau Island passing sulphur channel, green island and other outer islands.

Then take public transfer to the Po Lin Monastery. On the way, you pass by Cheung Sha beach, Shek Pik Reservoir, The Tranquil Tai O fishing village. At the Po Lin Monastery, situated high on a mountain you find the largest Buddha in the world, cast in bronze. A vegetarian lunch is served before returning by Ngong Ping Skyrail. It's a visually spectacular 5.7km cable car journey, travelling between Tung Chung Town Centre and Ngong Ping on Lantau Island. Guests will enjoy some of the best views in Hong Kong, as their cable car cabin glides over the

South China Sea and North Lantau Country Park on an amazing 20-25 minute experience. Transfer from Tung Chung to Hotel.

After a short resting in the afternoon, after dinner by your own, you will be transferred to Pier to board a cruise to enjoy the New Year's firework, one of the biggest in Asia, normally will last for 30 mins. And transfer back to hotel will be on your own.



Day 6) 30 Jan 17 Mon (B/L/-)

Buffet Breakfast at your hotel and then depart to New Territories for the Che Kung Temple which honors a military commander called Che Kung suppressed uprisings and plagues with Russian speaking guide. He also is the representative of loyalty and bravery in China. If you span three times



of the fan-bladed wheel of fortune which will bring good luck for coming year.



A lunch will be arrange enroute and then followed by a horse racing at Sha Tin Race course for celebrating the Lunar New year and try with your good luck
